

Waterloo Mennonite Brethren Church Designated Giving Policy

Waterloo Mennonite Brethren Church adopts this policy in order to comply with Trust Law & CRA guidelines in regards to designated giving. WMB Church will ensure that gifts or donations it receives which are designated for the support of a particular ministry are used solely for the purpose they were intended.

- All contributions are made unconditionally and without personal benefit to the donor.
- Contributions are made to or for the use of the church.
- No personal service is to be considered as a charitable gift.

Policy of the church:

1. A donation becomes a gift to the charity when it passes hands from the donor to the church and cannot be returned to the donor unless it does not fit into this policy.
2. Givers are encouraged to support the general offering of the church with their regular tithes and offerings.
3. The church will receive designated giving only to areas which are board approved or are already part of the churches approved budget.
4. Each restricted contribution designated towards such an approved program or project will be used as designated with the understanding that when the need for such a program or project has been met, or cannot be completed for any reason determined by the organization, the remaining restricted contributions will be used where needed most.
