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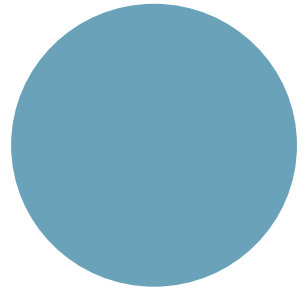
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4. How can I pray for Jesus to enter into your needs this coming week?

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Three '10-Year Discipleship' Challenges

- 1) **Relationship with God**—take another reading plan from the church and do it with someone else—anyone else (booklets are available from Lisa Matthews at the office).
- 2) **Relationship with the Church**—come once a month from 8:00 am to 8:30 am on Sunday mornings to pray for our church and for people in our community to be drawn into WMB.
- 3) **Relationship with the World**—invite someone to church weekly who doesn't normally come to WMB (this can be handing out flyers to neighbours or colleagues, a personal email, sharing a WMB facebook post, or by talking to someone directly) —celebrate with a staff member when someone comes, so we can pray for that person in staff meeting that week.
